Class of 2019 - currently pursuing a Bachelor in Civil engineering at Swinburne University of Technology, Australia

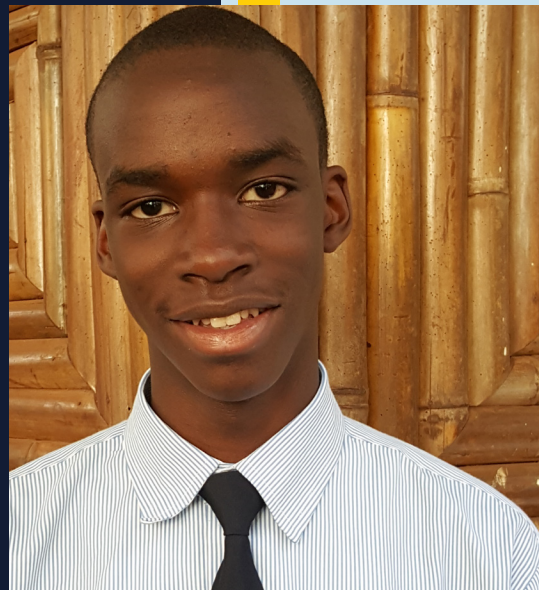
