- (a) Parents who make use of Payment Plan A (Annual Plan) are reminded that the annual fee is payable in advance and will be due on 31<sup>st</sup> December. Any parent who does not adhere to this timeline will be shifted to Payment Plan C.
- (b) Parents who make use of Payment Plan B (Termly Instalments) are reminded that termly payments are payable in advance and will be due on 01 January 2018 (Term 1), 01 May 2018 (Term 2) and 01 September 2018 (Term 3). Any parent who does not adhere to these timelines will have their Payment Plan shifted to Payment Plan C.
- (c) Parents who make use of Payment Plan C (11 monthly instalments) are reminded that monthly fees are payable in advance. All fees are due on 1<sup>st</sup> of every month and a debit order is required.

## DISCOUNTS

### FAMILY DISCOUNT

- The school offers parents a family discount of 5% for the second child and 2.5% thereafter.
- This family discount will be allocated to the tuition fee of any siblings.

### REFERRAL DISCOUNT

- The school offers parents a referral discount of 5%.
- This discount will only apply if the family referred is admitted and enrolled to the school in 2018.
- This discount is only applicable for one year (2018) and will be allocated to the tuition fee only.

## SUNDRY COSTS

### IT LEVY

- The IT Levy for 2018 has been set at R185 per month for Junior School Students and R240 per month for Senior School students. The IT Levy is payable for 11 months and is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month.

### GENERAL LEVY

- School Fees do not include textbooks, stationery (except in Grade R, Grade 1, Grade 2 and Grade 3 where class stationery is utilized and included in the General Levy) and other sundry items. A General Levy, which covers some of these items, will be billed on your statement in January. The breakdown of the General Levy for 2018 is as follows:

\* Current textbook costs are escalating tremendously. If the cost of textbooks were passed onto parents directly, they would be well over R4 000 per student, per year. In order to mitigate this cost, parents will be asked to contribute to the cost of the textbooks and workbooks, but they will not be owned by the students. Textbooks will be returned to the school at the end of the year so that they can be used by the next group. Students who lose textbooks, or who damage books beyond repair, will be asked to pay for the full replacement cost. *Any parent wishing to buy a set to keep should please contact the school so that the full cost can be allocated to your account.*

#### STATIONERY

- Stationery is included in the General Levy for Grade R, Grade 1, Grade 2 and Grade 3. For Grade 4, Grade 5, Grade 8, Grade 9, Grade 10 and Grade 11, stationery is *not* included in the General Levy. A stationery list will be provided and parents will be able to purchase on their own from their preferred supplier.

#### CAMBRIDGE EXAMINATIONS

- For 2018, the cost of writing the Cambridge Checkpoint for Grade 3 and Grade 9 and the cost of writing IGCSE examinations for Grade 11 have *not* been included in the general levy. These costs will be invoiced to parents when their children are entered to write these examinations.
